



CCTV security recording playback begins on May 12, 2008 at 1:26pm and 45 seconds at 25 John Street, Toronto, Ontario, M5V 3G6, Canada.

Stephen O’Keefe [dictating into digital voice recorder]: “You see me? Do you see me? Too late.”

O’Keefe enters the CBC building and approaches the security desk, where employee Fernando Serrano Orduna is seated. At 1:27pm and 11 seconds, O’Keefe clasps his hands on the desk to show Orduna the running voice recorder.

O’Keefe [to Orduna]: “Hi there. I was wondering...I was just asking...would you know my name if I brought this recorder in right now?”

Orduna : “Your what?”

O’Keefe : “My name.”

Orduna : “Your name?”

O’Keefe : “Yeah.”

Orduna : “What do ‘ya mean?”

O’Keefe : “Do you know my name?”

Orduna : “No.”

O’Keefe : “You don’t? Do you work for the CBC?”

Orduna : “Yes.”

O’Keefe : “Are you sure? You’re not a spy? You’re not guard for any government? Am I having a conspiracy theory with a recorder?”

Orduna : “No, why?”

O’Keefe : “Do I know about nine-eleven and the CBC?”

Orduna : “Excuse me?”

O’Keefe : “Do I know about nine-one-one and the CBC?”

CBC employee Shelagh O’Donnell arrives at the security desk, and stands behind O’Keefe, at 1:27pm and 35 seconds.

Orduna : “Yes.”

O’Keefe : “Because it’s very important that you’re clear right now or I’m going to murder psychically everyone in the CBC.”

Orduna : “Why?”

O'Keefe moves away from the CBC security desk, at 1:27pm and 45 seconds, now noticing that O'Donnell was standing behind him.

O'Keefe [repeating what was uttered before entering the building]: "Too late."

O'Donnell turns her head towards the CBC building entrance, looking at O'Keefe for one and a half seconds. O'Keefe shuts the digital voice recorder off and exits the CBC building to John Street.
